# **B.** Housekeeping Items:

- 1. Welcome Katie! (and Brianne if she can make it) Brianne Hanson was absent
- 2. Meeting Time Keeper and point out the "wood lot" Katie Boseo, Wood lot-Scott
- 3. Agenda changes (special guests, public input, etc.)
  - i. Brittany Roberts has resigned

  - Motion to approve the minutes made by Stefan, seconded by Nathan motion carried

#### C. New Business

- 1. WAEE Website
  - i. New branding/logo policies on campus. 6 months ago told we must use UWSP brand.
  - ii. WAEE was given a brand exception.
  - iii. Print and Design is still willing to print our materials. Less expensive to print on campus.
  - iv. UWSP website is going more mobile friendly and so because we have a brand exception we can still use our logo on the site but the "look" is being forced.
  - v. Jodi described the look of our current website show pictures of what it will look like.
  - vi. Options
    - 1. Stay on campus and merge with look
    - 2. Move to word press –we already have an account
    - 3. Have own website on Dreamhost-free for non- profits and we can use their word content management system. Pay to have them host?
    - 4. Katie's experience is with Sharepoint, not so much with Wordpress Jodi feels word press would be best. Emily redid the Friends of Wehr website she has Wordpress experience.
    - 5. Can have one administrator and then assign levels of users. Blog is on our website through Wordpress. General consensus is to move away from UWSP logo. Will use what the administrator will be most comfortable with. Wordpress is mobile and Google friendly. Susan would like one person to be the website administrator.
    - 6. We told UWSP don't move over until Aug 19<sup>th</sup>
      Jodi suggests we ask the CNR webmaster to not switch our site over because we are going off site.

- 7. Need to discuss staffing for this project. All on administrator? Workstudy student? Grant?
- 8. Stefan proposed that Jodi and Katie put together a plan for how much work is involved to switch over.
- 9. Jodi to train Katie on Wordpress in next few weeks
- 2. Google checkout no longer available after November 20<sup>th</sup>
  - i. Currently use for registration. Will have to switch to Google wallet.
- 3. Credit Card Security Policy Review & Approval
  - i. WAEE needs to have plan for how to handle credit card information. We lock up card numbers, we run the card, then we shred the numbers. We don't keep credit card numbers on file.
  - ii. The plan only applies to the hand swiped credit cards, not the Google credit card transactions. Through Google all credit card numbers are secured.
  - iii. We have to pay annually to be recertified. \$100
    - 1. Motion to approve the policy by Scott. Second by Katie. All in favor. motion passed.
- 4. Board of Director Elections (Update on student board members)
  - i. Brianne has accepted student position will start in September
  - ii. High school students? Not in our bylaws but on flyer says college student
    - 1. Ok to include 18 and above? Escuela Verde students, Conserve school, Spash students, 15 high school students with WI Conservation Leadership Corps
    - 2. Concerns are: commitment time of a high school student and being able to ride in a 15 passenger van
    - 3. Referenced in elections in bylaws and does not specify age of student
    - 4. On Website just say student
  - iii. Brittany Roberts has resigned
    - 1. Questions on appointing a member in her place:
    - 2. Appoint for half year? Start at new Year? Appoint someone for 1.5 years
  - iv. Nathan has accepted position in Illinois-leaving board after this year. Will maintain Facebook page until the end of the year.
  - v. Will have two one year terms to fill.
  - vi. Can use candidates from last election? Can ask the top 5 candidates to be on board and then ask the lower two to fill the one year term.
